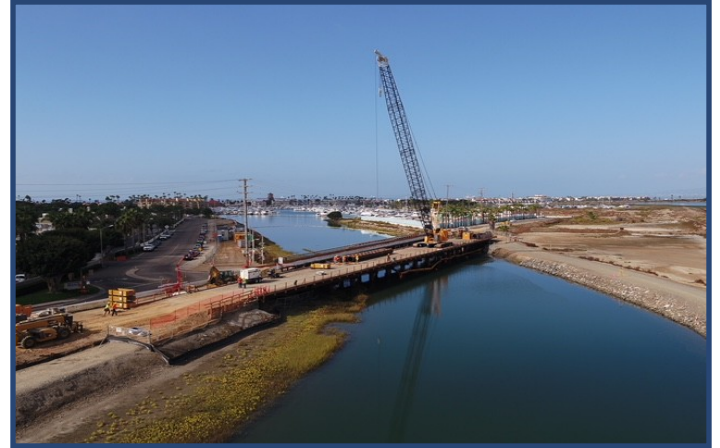


# PROJECT UPDATE

## Edinger Avenue Bridge Replacement Project: Pile Driving

Crews will resume pile driving activities at Edinger Avenue Bridge. Noise and vibrations are expected.

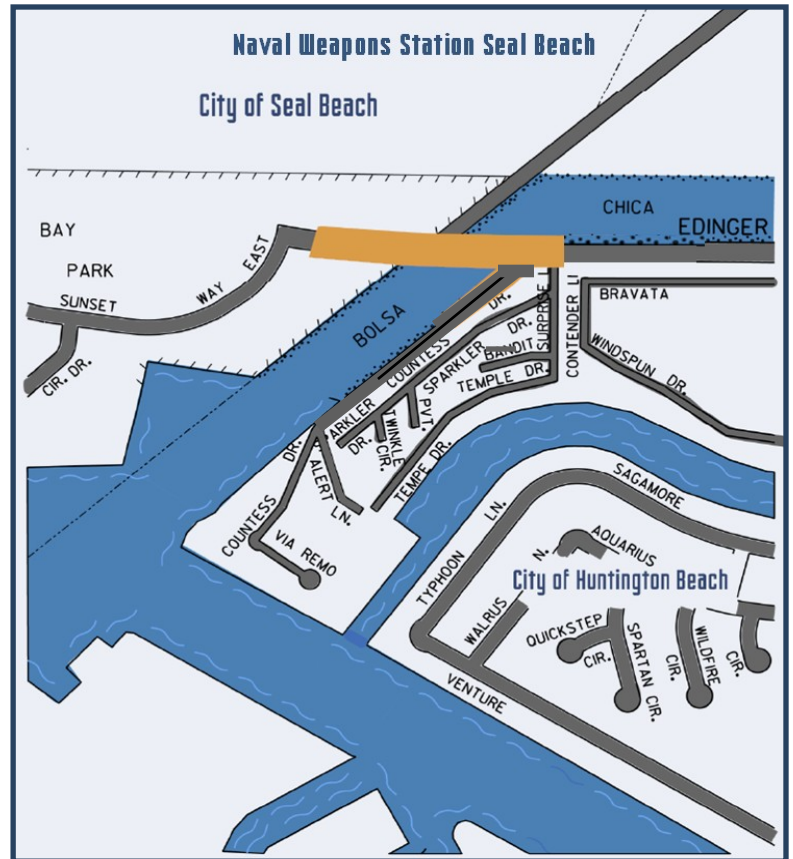


**WHAT:** The north-side portion of the Edinger Avenue Bridge replacement was substantially completed and **pile driving activities will now resume to complete the new south-side portion of the new bridge.** Piles are long poles made of steel and serve as support for the bridge deck load and are extremely important for the integrity of a bridge. **Nearby residents may experience periods of vibration and increased noise during this critical work.**

**WHEN:**

- Pile driving will resume intermittently **beginning Mon, Aug 13** and continue for 2 weeks (through late Aug)
- Then, after a 3 week period of no pile driving, pile driving will resume again in late Sept and continue for 2 weeks (through approx. mid-Oct)
- Overall project completion is anticipated in early 2019

**WHERE:** West end of Edinger Avenue in Huntington Beach, crossing the Bolsa Chica Channel to the Sunset Aquatic Marina
