Oso Parkway Bridge Project

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Oso Parkway Bridge Project will replace a portion of Oso Parkway with a new bridge structure to provide motorists with a direct connection between Los Patrones Parkway and State Route 241, thus improving traffic flow and safety on Oso Parkway. The future bridge will contain six lanes (three in each direction), dedicated bike lanes and sidewalks. Pedestrian access to Tesoro High School will be improved with the construction of a new sidewalk on the south side of Oso Parkway. Orange County Public Works will oversee construction of the two-year project.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Work on Oso Parkway will primarily be scheduled weekdays, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., with limited night work. At least two lanes will be open in each direction on Oso Parkway. Bike lanes will be impacted; motorists and bicyclists will share the road. Watch for construction signs when traveling through the project area. Separate weekend work will take place on State Route 241 to remove toll booths.
